
Winter Festival - Fed. 25

The Library will be sponsoring "Winter Stories" by The [Storycrafters](#), Jeri Burns and Barry Marshall, at Town Hall from 2 to 3. The Storycrafters' natural, energetic style has been featured in major festivals, schools and libraries in the US and abroad. They specialize in original retellings and modern renditions of world folklore, integrating music and song, poignancy & pizzazz. Publishers' Weekly describes them as 'top-notch family entertainment;' The Today Show has called them 'captivating', and the BBC has referred to them as 'brilliant.'



Come into the library on Saturday between 11 and 2 to do penguin crafts, including making a thermometer. Winter scene coloring sheets will also be available. Between 12 and 2 children accompanied by a parent or legal guardian can receive a free identification card which can be used in the event of an emergency.
