The next time you're waiting in a doctor's or dentist's office, remember that if you have your smart phone with you, you can read a magazine you actually like! If you see a magazine which looks interesting in a store, you may be able to download it for free while you're waiting in the checkout line. The Kent Library offers 151 popular



magazine titles, all free, all always available. The service has changed its name from Zinio to RBdigital, and it only takes a few minutes to put the RBdigital app on your cell phone or tablet.

## Audiobooks

Many newer cars no longer come with CD players. This fact is upsetting to people who have come to love books on CD. However, help is on the way! The Kent Library offers free downloadable audiobooks, through [Overdrive](#) and [Hoopla](#). (Hoopla also has thousands of music albums, as well as movies, etc..)



Download the Libby app for Overdrive, and/or the Hoopla app, and you can listen to books in any car you're driving or riding in. When you get home and take your device in with you, its easy to listen to that exciting conclusion while you fix dinner or do other chores.


